

# Health Safety Policy

Harborne Orchestra has a Covid-19 Risk Assessment which is available for Members on its' website via <https://www.harborneorchestra.com>

This document sets out the safety rules arising from that policy, and for general health safety during rehearsals and concerts.

1. Members should:
  - Bring their own cups to rehearsals to self-serve the tea and coffee provided;
  - Sanitise hands with the hand gel provided before using the tea and coffee making facilities.
  - Not attend a rehearsal or concert if feeling unwell or have any symptoms of covid, flu or other illness no matter how minor, including but not limited to a continuous cough, fever, sore throat, itchy eyes or sneezing;
  - Not attend within 5 days of knowingly having been in direct close contact with someone whilst they have tested positive for covid;
  - Not attend if they have tested positive for covid within 5 days of a rehearsal or concert.
2. Seating for rehearsals and concerts will be adequately spaced. Chairs should be set out prior to members arriving and then, as far as possible, not be moved.
3. Windows will be opened on arrival and remain open throughout a rehearsal or concert to provide ventilation.
4. Sufficient music will be supplied to the members so that they do not need to share copies or stands whilst playing if they do not feel comfortable to do so.
5. Members should notify the Committee via email at [orchestraharborne@gmail.com](mailto:orchestraharborne@gmail.com) if they test positive for covid within 5 days of attending a rehearsal or concert so that other members can be notified; no identifying details will be given out.
